


The first edition of the Abrupt festival will take place from 9 to 13 October 2024

Reset, Bozar, C12, AB and Botanique bring together 5 days of artistic innovation, debates, club events and concerts

From 9 to 13 October 2024, the team behind Reset proudly presents its new flagship festival: Abrupt. Following in the footsteps of Nuits sonores Brussels, this newcomer to the Brussels' festival scene defines itself as a Festival-Forum that fuses music, dialogue and the exchange of ideas. More than 7 concert nights, 6 club events and multiple talks and conferences will be featured in collaboration with Bozar, Botanique, C12, Reset and AB, but also in exceptional venues including the Cathédrale Saints-Michel-et-Gudule and Usquare.

Some of the highlights of this first edition include the opening concert with Astrid Sonne and the world premiere of Kevin Richard Martin (aka The Bug) & KMRU presenting their new album Disconnect (09.10); a live concert on church organ by belgian artist Maxime Denuc in the Cathédrale Saints-Michel-et-Gudule (10.10); a new format with both rooms of Reset opening simultaneously - where on friday the Brussels collective Brikabrak and the famous Ugandan collective Nyege Nyege will link up to present a line-up together featuring Brazilian Funk prodigy DJ Anderson do Paraiso (11.10) and on Saturday Abrupt and Bozar present a cutting-edge clubnight with a rare back to back session by Actress & Skee Mask and a special 20 years history of Hyperdub set by Kode9. The legendary label's boss will make a double appearance at the festival, presenting a live A/V performance earlier that day at Bozar, right after Belgian artists SKY H1 & Mika Oki (12.10); two daytime "warehouse parties" in collaboration with C12 at Usquare in Ixelles, with artists like Marcel Dettmann, Dasha Rush & Fafi Abdel Nour (12 & 13.10); the return of Lanark Artefax at Botanique, presenting an A/V show of his first album in almost 7 years (12.10) as well as the meeting between producer and pianist Laurel Halo and cellist Leila Bordreuil in the intimate setting of Reset's Auditorium (11.10).
